For Parents: Three Years of Results (2023–2026)

WHAT PARENTS NEED TO KNOW: FSML combines fantasy football with real math practice. Since 2023, three separate studies — in different states, with different students — have found the same thing: boys and girls who play FSML improve their math skills and feel less anxious about fractions, whether they already loved math or didn't.

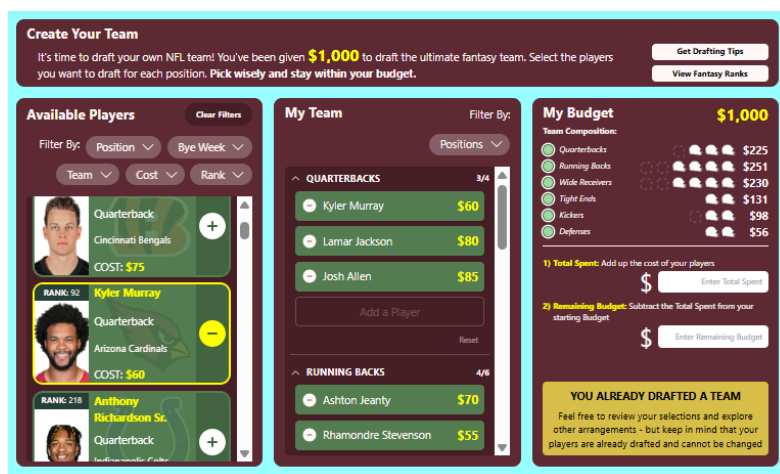

WHAT MAKES IT WORK:

- Real math practice: kids solve fraction and budgeting problems every week to score their fantasy team.

- Consistent results: three studies across three years and multiple states have found similar patterns in skill gains and reduced math anxiety.
- Safe & supervised: used in a secure platform at school or at home, COPPA and FERPA compliant, no ads, no online chat or messaging.
